NBO is pleased to invite NBO Members and conference attendees to show their work at the NBO's biennial conference being held on the campus of University of Puget Sound in Tacoma, Washington. The exhibition, "More to Consider 2", is an open, unjuried invitational for work of NBO Members and conference attendees that will be displayed at the beautiful Kittredge Gallery on the campus of the University of Puget Sound from Wednesday evening, July 19, 2017 through lunch, Saturday, July 22, 2017. We'd like to thank the Guild Advisory Committee for their efforts in supporting More to Consider 2.

More to Consider 2 is intended to encourage, inspire and connect. There is no judge, no jury, no awards, no fee to participate. Work may be offered for sale at the option of the participant. To support the NBO, participants whose work is offered for sale will agree to the NBO receiving a commission of 30% of the sale price set by the participant. All levels, techniques and materials are welcome and all participants will receive a certificate of participation. We hope you will choose to take part in what is sure to be an exciting and fun look at the diverse work of basket artists from across the country.

Now the "rules." This exhibition is open to NBO members and all persons attending the conference. Please, one piece per person! Anyone attending the conference may also hand-deliver one additional piece created by an NBO member who is unable to attend the conference. All work must be hand-delivered to the Kittredge Gallery by 5:00 pm, PST on Tuesday, July 18th (the opening day of the conference). All work MUST be picked up by 2:00 pm, PST on Saturday, July 22, 2017. Any work left after that time will become the property of NBO. NBO cannot take responsibility for return shipping under any circumstances.

To assist the MTC2 Team in creating a great exhibit, we'd appreciate receiving your completed and signed Registration Form and Agreement prior to June 1, 2017, however the MTC2 Team will be happy to accept some additional work on the conference opening date, July 18, 2017. The Registration Form and Agreement can be downloaded from the NBO website under <u>Events</u> and must be completed and returned to the NBO. To receive a paper copy of the form, please send a self-addressed, stamped envelope to NBO, P.O. Box 1524, Gloucester, MA 01931-1524. Completed forms may be scanned and emailed to moretoconsider@nationalbasketry.org or mailed to the NBO P.O. Box address above.

There is no fee for participation. NBO is authorized to sell work as agreed by the participant at prices determined by the participant. Prices for the work will be available upon request by a potential buyer and will not be posted on the individual item tags in the Gallery. **The NBO receives a 30% commission on all sales and all appropriate sales taxes will be collected.** Checks will be issued to the participant for any sale by the 30th day of August following the conclusion of the conference. Any participants authorizing sale of the Work will be required to provide a social security number or tax ID # at the time the work is delivered to the gallery. A W-9 is attached to the Registration Form and Agreement for this purpose.

ALL participants are asked to approve photography rights and limit liability during the exhibition. The Kittredge Gallery hours will be posted during the conference and at all other times will be locked to secure the work. An attendant will be on duty when the Gallery is open. Neither NBO, nor the host facility, will be providing insurance for this exhibition.
