

The National Basketry Organization is pleased to once again invite NBO Members and conference attendees to show their work at the NBO's biennial conference being held on the campus of Western Kentucky University in Bowling Green, Kentucky. *More Basketry* (formerly *More to Consider*) is an open, unjuried invitational for work of NBO Members and conference attendees that will be displayed at the beautiful FAC University Gallery on the campus of Western Kentucky University from Wednesday evening, July 17, 2019 at 7:00 pm through 1:00 pm, Saturday, July 20, 2019. We'd like to thank the NBO Guild Advisory Committee for their efforts in once again supporting *More Basketry*.

More Basketry is intended to encourage, inspire and connect. There is no judge, no jury, no awards, no fee to participate. The Work may be offered for sale at the option of the participant. To support the NBO, participants whose Work is offered for sale will agree to the NBO receiving a commission of 30% of the sale price set by the participant. All levels, techniques and materials are welcome and all participants will receive a certificate of participation. We hope you will choose to take part in what is sure to be an exciting and fun look at the diverse work of basket artists from across the country.

Now the "rules." This exhibition is open to NBO members and all persons attending the conference. Please, one entry per person! Anyone attending the conference may also hand-deliver one additional piece created by an NBO member who is unable to attend the conference. All Work must be hand-delivered to the Gallery by 5:00 pm, CST on Tuesday, July 16 (the opening day of the conference). All Work MUST be picked up by 1:00 pm, CST on Saturday, July 20, 2019 because at that time, we will be accepting work for the final exhibition of the conference, the More Basketry, A Weeks Work. Any Work left after that time will become the property of NBO. NBO cannot take responsibility for return shipping under any circumstances.

When dropping off Work for the exhibit, ALL participants, whether attending the conference or not, must complete the Registration Form. You can view and download the Registration Form on the NBO website. The registration form will also be available on-site for completion and signing when dropping off the Work.

There is no fee for participation. NBO is authorized to sell work as agreed by the participant at prices determined by the participant. Prices for the work will be available upon request by a potential buyer and will not be posted on the individual item tags in the Gallery. Although we will include whether the Work is for sale or not. The NBO receives a 30% commission on all sales and all appropriate sales taxes will be collected. Checks will be issued to the participant for any sale by the 30th day of August following the conclusion of the conference. Any participants authorizing sale of the Work for a price **equal to or more than \$600** will be required to provide a signed W-9 tax ID at the time the work is delivered to the Gallery. ALL participants are asked to approve photography rights and limit liability during the exhibition. Gallery hours will be posted during the conference and at all other times will be locked to secure the work. Neither NBO, nor the University, will be providing insurance for this exhibition.
