Bryant Holsenbeck: Collection -Transformation - Installation

List of tools materials, etc. required for each student to bring:

- Fabric scraps of all kinds—bring what you have to share. We can also cut up old t-shirts or other discarded clothing. If you have a favorite t-shirt or some old socks that you love and that are threadbare—this would be a good time to transform them into art! Please bring fabric that can be cut into long strips for wrapping as well as smaller bits that can be used for accents and stuffing. Bring lots to share and trade.
- Yarn, string and thread—stuff to wrap with

LOTS AND LOTS of Plastic bags for stuffing. It takes at least one BIG!! stuffed bag of bags per animal, and you will want to make more than one! If you are driving and can bring bags to share that would be great! It is much better to have too many!!!

- Buttons, beads, feathers, sticks, rocks and other personal treasures to share and for embellishment.
- Wire —any gage—that you might already have. Please do not purchase wire. I will supply each student with a roll of the wire that I have found works best for the process I will be teaching.
- Safety glasses!!!! THIS IS IMPORTANT!
- Printed images of animals and birds you are thinking of making
- A journal for drawing and sketching.
- A small bottle of PVA or fabric glue
- A cutting mat to protect tables if you have one.

- Tools-- i.e. cloth scissors, pliers, especially needle nose, any sewing needles you might have around, awls of all sizes and shapes
