Estimated workshop fee: \$30 to \$35

List of tools, materials, etc., required for each student to bring:

- Small and large sharp scissors
- Pen, pencil, notebook
- T-pins, push pins, two curved needles with large eyes (one small and another medium sized)
- A small wire cutter, small garden clippers
- Thimble, awl, ruler (6"-12" long with even, smooth edges and/or a wooden tongue depressor or popsicle stick)
- Roll of masking tape or other tape
- Roll of dental floss
- Small tubes of acrylic paint (white, black and one other color)
- Small container for mixing paint
- 1/2" paintbrush
- One stiffening agent (e.g. glue, wax, ModPodge, acrylic medium, etc.)
- Something for you that meaningfully reflects a memory and/or time or place
- Images of your own art work to share
- Please also bring one rag, like an old dish towel
- 24 gauge coper wire, 100'@\$7.50
- 24 gauge dark annealed general purpose steel wire, 100', @\$4.50
- One quart plastic leftover container with a tight-fitting lid
