Estimated workshop fee: \$35. Includes Fiber rush, watercolor paper, acrylic paints, brushes, Japanese rice paper, modpodge, masking tape, dowels, reed, mixed media, tape, papers.

List of tools, materials, etc., required for each student to bring:

- Self-healing cutting mat (no smaller than 18x24)
- A good utility knife with extra blades
- Metal ruler with cork backing at least 24" long so it doesn't slip
- Pencil
